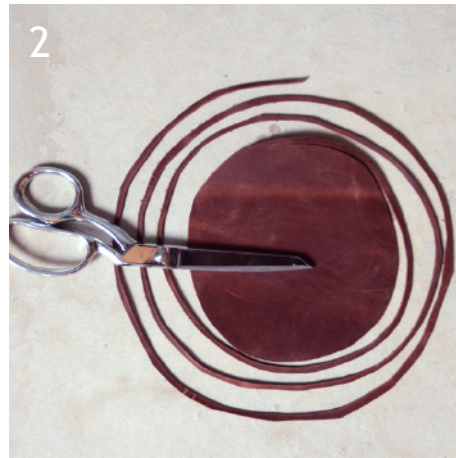
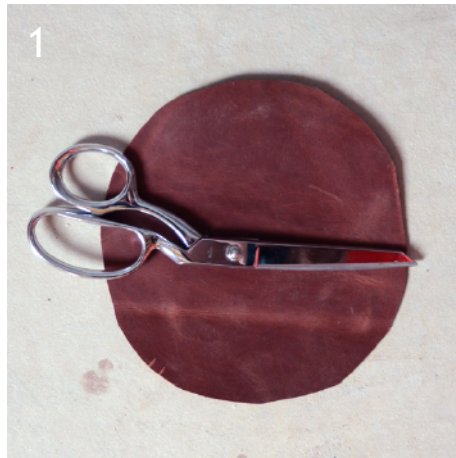


ADJUSTABLE LEATHER BRACELET

SUPPLIES

- scissors
- leather
- nail polish



Cut your leather into thin strips. If you don't have a long enough scrap of leather, cut out a circle

Cut your leather strip from the small scrap by cutting in a spiral. Try to be as uniform as possible. Variations in width add character so don't be afraid of messing up!

Once you have your desired length, overlap each end & tie a granny knot around the other end with the tail. (see lovely indeed for exact tutorial)

OPTIONAL
Before tying your adjustable knot, slip on some beads or leather pieces. I cut mine in a small rectangle with a hole at either end. Paint with nail polish if desired.
